

The organisers request everyone's cooperation to ensure the program runs as scheduled. Pit gates will be closed at the advertised times or until deemed closed by the Officer of the Day or their designated representative. If there are issues whilst on route to the venue, please notify the MRSBC race Secretary Clare Shepherdley 0409 671 224.

Drivers Packs: Drivers packs will be available at the Race Tower upon your arrival to the Venue

on Friday and Saturday morning. After your boat has been scrutineered, you will need to produce all relevant paperwork including your Rule Book/License

and Logbook to the Race Tower.

It is the responsibility of the drivers to arrive on time, have their

paperwork in order and be scrutineered in a timely manner.

Scrutineering: Scrutineering will be held on Friday the 16th of February in the pits. As there

is limited time on Saturday for scrutineering, please make every effort to arrive on Friday. If you need to be scrutineered on Saturday morning, please

be prompt in arriving as we will only be scrutineering until 8.00am sharp.

Practice: Practice will take place from 10.00am – 2.00pm on Friday afternoon only. Boats

must be scrutineered, and all drivers' breath tested before entering on to the

water.

Breath Testing: Breath testing will be conducted immediately prior to the drivers briefing on

each day of competition. Random alcohol and drug tests will be conducted throughout each day. All drivers and officials must undergo a breath test and record a zero reading on each day of competition and when requested for random breath testing. If a positive reading is returned, that driver cannot compete at that day's racing. If the breath analysis equipment is considered faulty, Officials may afford a driver a second test or use other breath analysis equipment if available. Such a test is to be conducted (as per Rule 201.096) within 10 (ten) minutes of the original test or the minimum recommended

interval as given by the manufacturer of the equipment.

Drivers Briefing: The Drivers briefing will be held near the race tower on Friday and in

Downstairs Café on Saturday and Sunday, it is compulsory for all drivers and

owners to attend.

Fuel:

200 litres of methanol will be provided to competitors; additional methanol will be available on the day at a cost to be advised. Please be in contact with Mark Shepherdley 0400 029 062 if alternatives are required.

Pits:

The Pits are located within the boat and trailer parking area and the top parking area including the sheds of Melbourne Runabout and Speedboat Club.

There is plenty of room for small and large transporters and trailers, but please notify us when entering if you have one so we can probably plan out the space.

Extra cars will not be permitted in the pits on Saturday or Sunday. There are enough car spaces outside of the pits for cars.

Access to the pits is restricted to personnel wearing a valid pit pass (Children included). The pits will be fenced and have strict enforcement of all rules for safety and public liability.

Pit Etiquette:

The Pit Area is marked, and the following conditions apply:

- No Pit Pass (Wristband), No Entry
- No open toe footwear under any circumstances
- No Smoking and No Alcohol
- No BBQ's
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult unless competing.
- No riding on trailers. Only the driver is permitted to be seated in their boat while travelling to the ramp from the top pits.
- Under no circumstances is there to be refuelling on the water. Refuelling is permitted in the pit area, including on the ramps when they are stationery while at the top.

Ramp Assistance:

To ensure quick launch and retrieval of boats, we ask that each team provides two (2) of their crew to assist as ramp riders for the event. We will also supply one (1) MRSBC volunteer to assist on water and one to operate.

Volunteers & Crew:

For insurance purposes, all officials, volunteers, drivers, and crew must sign the APBA volunteer register to be covered by their policy. Failure to do so may result in coverage not being provided in the event of an incident. The register will be available at the Race Tower, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday morning.

Speed Bracket Racing:

There will be a designated area at the Race Tower for all competitors to collect and return your GPS at the end of each race for checking and re-setting. It is the responsibility of the team to ensure this process is followed within 10 minutes of the completion of the race, failing to do so will result in disgualification.

Incidents:

In the unlikely event your boat is involved in an incident, you are required to follow all directions from officials. If your boat requires inspection, it will need to remain in your pit area and remain there until released by officials.

The club will be utilising drone and various cameras covering the course to assist in managing the event. This will be relied upon in adjudicating breaches of racing rules and protests.

Safety Personnel:

Safety boats, rescue boats, divers and paramedics will be present at the event. Please introduce yourself to the safety personnel and allow them to familiarise themselves with your boat. If your vessel is fitted with anything other than what could be considers a standard air system, latches, or other safety devices, it is the responsibility of the driver and team to make time to provide details and instructions with the safety team.

Code of Conduct:

The MRSBC will not tolerate any abuse or disrespect of any officials or volunteers.

- Any matter that a driver feels is not being handled/managed in a manner they believe is satisfactory should direct their concerns to the Commodore of the MRSBC, Chris Dynon.
- Any crew or team that feels that a matter is not being handled/managed in a manner they believe is satisfactory should direct their concerns to the Commodore of the MRSBC, Chris Dynon.
- Formula Future drivers can be represented by a parent, guardian, or other representative.
- If the matter is related to the Commodore of the MRSBC, the driver may choose to direct their matter to another Executive of the MRSBC, who will manage the matter/concern.
- The MRSBC considers any post to social media that is defamatory towards the club, sport, or other competitors to included as disrespect and/or abuse.

Failure to conduct yourself, or your team, in a manner the represents the sport in professional light shall be directed to the state and/or national bodies for management under their rules and process, such as the APBA Member Protection Policy.
